





EDWARD THE EMU BINGO COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Two identical competitions will run concurrently at all Penrith City Library branches.
 - Competition 1** – at Penrith Central Library branch runs from 9am, Wednesday 5 October 2022 to 5pm, Tuesday 22 November 2022.
 - Competition 2** – at St Marys and St Clair Library branches runs from 9am, Wednesday 5 October 2022 to 5pm, Sunday 20 November 2022.
- Entry is open to children aged 4-10 years old.
- A limit of one entry per child, per competition.
- Entries must contain at least 1 correctly completed horizontal, vertical or diagonal line to be valid.
- Entries must be submitted in person to the locked competition barrel at any Penrith City Library branch during library opening hours and no later than:
 - Competition 1** – 5pm, Tuesday 22 November 2022 at Penrith Central library branch
 - Competition 2** – 5pm, Sunday 20 November 2022 at St Marys library or St Clair library branch
- Two prize draws, one for each competition, will be held at Penrith Central Library branch at 5.15pm on Tuesday 22 November 2022.
- One winner will be drawn for each competition and will be the first valid entry drawn in each draw.
- Winners will be notified by phone or email no later than 30 November 2022.
